### DESCRIPTION

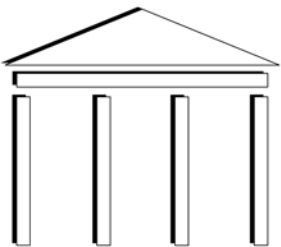
Fenimore Art Museum is the museum showcase for the New York State Historical Association. The Museum is housed in an elegant 1930s mansion, which was built as a private residence. The house became the headquarters of the New York State Historical Association in 1945 at the invitation of philanthropist Stephen C. Clark, Sr. The Museum houses premier collections of fine art, folk art, and American Indian art that have grown to represent and illuminate our cultural heritage and to celebrate America's artistic traditions and history.

### DIRECTIONS

The museum is located 1 mile north of the Village of Cooperstown on State Route 80 on the west side of Otsego Lake. It is a regular day stop on the Cooperstown Village Trolley route. If you are on foot, the museum is a 1.5-mile walk from the village of Cooperstown. There is a sidewalk on the left side of the road heading out of the village, and a pedestrian crosswalk at the entrance to the museum.
