DIRECTIONS

From Thruway (Eastbound) - Exit 30 to Rt 28, Richfield Spgs., Rt 20 East to Springfield Center, Rt 80 South and follow signs.

From Albany – Thruway to I-88, Exit 24, Rt 20 West, East Springfield, County Rt 31

Northbound I-88 – Exit 17, Rt 28 to Cooperstown, at light take right, straight ahead to Co. Rt 31
